1.	Welcome, apologies and note of the last Board & Management Group (RT)			
	Pam Babes (NMS) was welcomed to her first meeting as a Programme Board member. Robin Turner noted that John Pelan, new Director of the Scottish Council on Archives, has expressed an interest in participating.			
2.	Implementation Plan			
	RT led the group through the updates made to the Implementation Plan, which will be amended. A request was made for relevant standards to be featured on the SHED webpages .			
	There was discussion of <u>SEWeb</u> and the need for current historic environment data and of the risk of multiple portals and duplication of effort.			
	The role of the SHED Programme Board was discussed. Members requested clarity over their roles and a reassessment of priorities, which will make it simpler to drive things forward. Alan Leslie offered to help explore funding.	Action 01 RT and AL to discuss funding.

	3.1 SHED Management Group The note of the meeting has been circulated.			
	3.2 Workstream 1: PastMap Programme (AA)			
	Alex Adamson demonstrated the refreshed PastMap website. There will be user testing in the next two weeks, with implementation by the end of 2017.			
	3.3 Workstream 2: SMR Forum Technical Working Group			

	The TWG met recently and it was noted that getting HERs online (through a bid by HBSMR users) was discussed.	
	3.4 Workstream 3: Comms (EM & RT) Eila Macqueen tabled a draft Communications Plan, and requested feedback on the questions posed by the paper. EM suggested liaison with Kevin Grant (HES) who runs comms for the Archaeology Strategy.	Action 03 EM to form a group looking at Comms
	There was discussion of who the audience is for SHED, and the importance of knowing who the target audience should be, with agreement that it is important for local and national government to be aware of the sector working together under the SHED banner. It was noted that while SHED itself is an example of cross-sector working and a 'good news story', other news stories, such as the relaunch of PastMap, could be tagged or associated with SHED. 	Pam Babes noted that she hadn't heard of SHED before being involved, reinforcing the need to promote SHED.	
	3.5 Workstream 4: Museums and Archives (AA) AA noted that a brief report on Workstream 4 had been circulated.	
	Hugh McBrien noted two projects which may be of use to WS4; one in Oxfordshire, linking museum and site records, and one in Glasgow, linking WOSAS records to Glasgow Museum records.	
	Jane Brown noted that it was important to consider and define the scope of WS4, for example, is it looking at just digital or also analogue archive? JB also suggested that university archives may be a good place to look for potential projects.	Action 05 JB to suggest archive leads to AA
4.	Polygonisation Project update (AA) Alex Adamson reported that the Shetland project was nearing completion, Borders is approximately 40% complete and Stirling and Clackmannanshire c. 30% complete. Dave Sutton noted that a further discussion on methodology relating to Listed Building curtilages is required. Alan Leslie noted that funding is available from European programmes, but that time is urgent.	
5.	Risk Register – update (RT) The Risk Register has been updated and Robin Turner noted that two risks had been reduced.	
6.	Matters arising from previous meetings Most matters arising were dealt with during the course of the meeting. Some long-outstanding matters have been closed or included in other tasks.	
7.	AOCB Robin Turner noted that the Culture Strategy is currently being developed and that information of the sort SHED is interested in should be important to the historical dimension of the Strategy.
